CONDITIONS:

1. *All nominations open via Campdraft Central; **Thursday 4th January 12noon until Friday 5th January 12noon**. All nominations must be **paid in full by Wednesday 10th January**, if not paid nominations will be scratched to make room for wait listed competitors - nominations are confirmed only on receipt of payment made in full. Scratchings received after **8am Sunday 14th January** will incur an \$11 stock levy. Scratchings received after **8am Wednesday 17th** will forfeit all nominations.*

2. *Nominations are subject to restrictions upon excess entries. The committee reserves the right to alter the program. Cheques not banked within 6 months will be cancelled. Prizemoney will be paid according to ACA Rules R8 & R9*
3. *All competitors ride at their own risk and must be an ACA member before competing.*
4. *Riders under the age of 18 must wear helmets whilst mounted on a horse at all ACA affiliated events. Helmets must comply with current safety standards and be securely fastened under the chin at all times*
5. *Stallions to be enclosed as per ACA rule 11.12 & cannot be ridden by any persons under 18 years of age.*
6. *The status of a horse winning a campdraft will be determined by the highest class of horse that competes with the exception of Juniors, Juveniles, Ladies, Old Buffers, Associates & Encouragement Campdrafts. The winner attains the status of the highest class of horse participating e.g. if 1 open horse competes then it is classed as an open draft.*
