A fee of \$20 must be lodged with the complaint. If the complaint is dismissed by the Committee, the \$20 is forfeited.
Riders under the age of 18 must wear Helmets whilst mounted on a horse at all ACA affiliated events. Helmets must comply with current safety standards and must be securely fastened under the chin at all times. To be eligible for additional prizes, all details must be provided at time of nomination.
ALL PRIZE MONEY WILL BE ALLOCATED AS PER ACA RULES. The showgrounds will open on Friday morning and close on Monday evening, camping at grounds outside this time may incur a camping fee imposed by Western Downs Regional Council.

If Stabling is used, please ensure they are left bare, as failure to do so will result in the committee incurring penalty from the Western Downs Regional Council, this will in turn be passed on to the competitors. The committee reserves the right to charge \$30 per stall if not left bare. Previous offenders have been noted!

Please note that unvaccinated horses may not be treated by our local vets.
Biosecurity Declarations and Horse Movements Records must be completed & submitted on arrival.
