Nominations & Conditions:

- All nominations are via Campdraft Central Website <http://www.campdraftcentral.com.au/>. Phone or mail nominations will not be accepted.
- Nominations are limited to 10 first round runs.
- Nominations open on Sunday 29th July 2018 at 12pm and will remain open until Monday 30th July 2018, 12pm. Nominations are subject to restrictions if excess entries are received. Competitors will be invoiced after nominations have been finalised, by Sunday 5th August 2018. If nominations are not exceeded, nominations will remain open until full.
- All nominations must be paid in full by Friday 10th August 2018. If payment is not received by this date, nominations will be scratched to make way for waitlisted competitors. Nominations confirmed only by receipt of payment in full.
- Direct deposit is preferred: BSB 034-274, ACC NO 111365. Cheques must be made payable to Moura Campdraft Committee Inc. and posted to The Nominations Officer, PO Box 134, Moura QLD 4718.
- A 100% refund of the nomination fee will be given if the competitor withdraws more than 168 hours (7 days) prior to 8.00am on the first morning of the program. If a competitor withdraws between 96 hours (4 days) and 168 hours (7 days) prior to 8.00am on the first morning of the program \$15 per horse per draft shall be withheld and the balance of the nomination fee refunded. If a competitor withdraws within 96 hours (4 days) prior to 8.00am on the first morning of the program, the entire nomination fee may be retained by the Committee. If the Committee deems that extenuating circumstances apply, then a refund may be granted. Each case will be at the discretion of the Committee.
- All competitors ride at their own risk and must be an ACA member before riding (day memberships no longer exist)
- The committee reserves the right to alter or delete any event
- Prize monies will be paid via direct deposit and refunds will be by cheque, posted on Wednesday 12th July 2017. Breakdown of prizemoney will be as per ACA guidelines R9.b. Cheques must be banked within 6 months or they will be cancelled.
- The committee will not be held responsible for any theft, accident or damage to a competitor or their equipment.
- Any competitor who is not present after 3 calls will be disqualified. Draw will be adhered to.
- Any competitor showing signs of intoxication will be banned.
- ACA rule B.5 – Riders under the age of 18 must wear Helmets whilst mounted on a horse at all ACA affiliated events. Helmets must comply with current safety standards and must be securely fastened under the chin at all times.
- Stallions must be restrained as per ACA guidelines and may not be ridden by persons under 18 years of age.
- Any competitor wishing to lodge a complaint must do so in writing within 1 hour of the incident, and must be accompanied by a \$20 fee. This fee will be forfeited if the case is dismissed.

Grounds Etiquette:

- Do not drive vehicles or ride horses on the football, cricket or soccer grounds.
- Parking is limited at the grounds. Please be mindful of this when making fences.
- Keep footpaths clear.
- A warm up area is provided. Please use this area when warming up your horse.
- A grey water and black water dump-point is available on Bindaree Road. Please, be respectful of others and our town, and use this when disposing of waste.

LIMITED POWER AVAILABLE

‘The status of a horse winning a campdraft will be determined by the highest class of horse that competes with the exception of Juniors, Juveniles, Ladies, Old Buffers, Associates and Encouragements campdrafts. The winner attains the status of the highest class of horse participating (eg if one Open horse competes then it is classed as an Open draft) on program. Rider &/or horse may break status.’
