1. The committee reserves the right to alter or amend the program at any time and the committee's decision is final.
2. The committee reserves the right to refuse entries without any reason.
3. Horses to be nominated in order in which horses are to be ridden.
4. All competitors compete at their own risk. Each competitor must acknowledge that it is a condition of acceptance of their nomination that neither the Cooranga North Rec. Reserve Inc. nor the Western Downs Regional Council will be responsible for any injury, loss or damage.
5. Full nomination fees must accompany entries. Entries to be received on Campdraft Central 23<sup>rd</sup> March.
6. Nominations refundable if scratched by 1<sup>st</sup> April prior to the draft at 8am. Scratching's after this time will incur a cattle levy (\$15). Any scratchings after 8am 5<sup>th</sup> April will forfeit nomination fees. Requests for changes to horse/rider per run will be limited to 1 change only.
7. Competitors are to run in order of draw.
8. **Riders under the age of 18 must wear helmets whilst mounted on a horse at all ACA affiliated events. Helmets must comply with current safety standards and be securely fastened under the chin.**
8. All competitors must be current ACA members in order to nominate.
9. Any competitor who wishes to lodge a complaint at an affiliated campdraft must lodge the complaint in writing with the Secretary of the host committee within one (1) hour of the incident taking place. A fee of \$20 in cash must be lodged with the complaint. If the complaint is dismissed by the Committee, the \$20 is forfeited. The committee's decision is final.
10. Volunteers and committee workers must be shown respect at all times. If competitor abuses any volunteer or committee member, the committee may ask competitor to leave and all unused nomination fees may be forfeited, less cattle levy.
11. There is a limit of 4 first round runs per competitor over the duration of the draft.
