





SPECIAL CONDITIONS OPEN DRAFT

CONDITIONS

- 1. All competitors must be current 2018/2019 financial members of the ACA. Nominations will be limited and numbers are restricted to the first fully paid first round nominations received.
- 2. Horses to be nominated in order in which horses are to be ridden.
- 3. Any horse, rider or combination of, may change up until the start of the 1st round of the Open Draft. In the event of a change the secretary must be notified prior to the commencement of the 1st round.
- 4. Campdraft competitors must hold themselves ready to compete at the advertised starting time on the day of draft. If the competitor fails to appear nomination fees paid or due shall be forfeited to Condamine Campdraft Committee.
- 5. All competitors compete at own risk.
- 6. All prize money listed is GST inclusive.
- 7. Judge's decision is final.
- 8. Refunds and prize money will be paid out by direct deposit following the event. To receive payment promptly competitors are requested to ensure their current banking details are provided on Campdraft Central.
- 9. All competitors must complete a horse health declaration form attached to this program, and hand to the Secretary's Office immediately upon arrival at the Chinchilla Show Grounds.
- 10. Per ACA rule B5 (e) Riders under the age of 18 must wear Helmets whilst mounted on a horse at all ACA affiliated events. Helmets must comply with current safety standards and must be securely fastened under the chin at all times. Riders under the age of 18 must wear skull caps in the main arena.
- 11. Junior competitors under the age of 13 are not permitted to compete in any drafts other than the Junior Draft.
- 12. The committee reserves the right to change the order of the program and also close nominations and alter/delete or adjudicate on any event.
- 13. Any competitor who wishes to lodge a complaint at an affiliated campdraft must lodge the complaint in writing with the Secretary of the host committee within one (1) hour of the incident taking place. A fee of \$20 must be lodged with the complaint. If the complaint is dismissed by the Committee, the \$20 is forfeited.
- 14. All competitors must complete a horse health declaration form attached to this program, and hand to the Secretary's Office upon arrival at the Condamine Sports Grounds.
- 15. Per ACA rule B5 (e) Riders under the age of 18 must wear Helmets whilst mounted on a horse at all ACA affiliated events. Helmets must comply with current safety standards and must be securely fastened under the chin at all times. Riders under the age of 18 must wear skull caps in the main arena.
- 16. Neither the organising committee, Western Downs Council nor the ACA accept any liability for any accident, damage, loss or illness to horses, riders, beast or any other person or property whatsoever.

NOMINATIONS

- 1. Nominations must be paid in full by cheque or direct deposit by 5pm Thursday 4th October 2016
- 2. Withdrawals received after 8am Friday 5th October will forfeit a \$10 fee. Withdrawals received after 9am Monday 8th October will forfeit the whole amount of nominations, unless extenuating circumstances apply.
