RULES and Regulations

There is a maximum of Four first round starts excluding Junior and Juvenile events,

applies to all competitors.

Scratching's: Rule D.5; must be made 72 hours before 06:00am Saturday to ensure a refund. All scratching's after the 72-hour cut-off are down to committee discretion.

Juvenile: Riders to be 13yrs - under 17yrs. Limit of 2 horses. Juvenile riders are not permitted to ride in open age events

Junior: Riders to be 8yrs - under 13yrs. Limit of 2 horses. Junior riders are not permitted to ride in open age events

Helmets: must be worn by ALL competitors under the age of 18yrs whilst mounted on a horse at all ACA affiliated events. Helmets must comply with current safety standards and must be securely fastened under the chin at all times.

Encouragement: An Encouragement campdraft competitor shall be 17 years and over and one who has not won 1 Encouragement or 1 Open age draft or placed 3 times in an Open age campdraft. Rule 10.4

RULE 9.4: The status of a horse winning a campdraft will be determined by the highest class of horse that competes with the exception of Juniors, Juveniles, Ladies, Old buffers, Associates and Encouragement campdrafts. The winner attains the status of the highest class of the horse participating.

Stallions: Stallions will be allowed to be unrestrained in panel yards through day light hours ONLY. Only 1 horse is allowed per enclosure. Stallions must be double tied at night time. Panels must be a minimum of 1500mm in height. Panels must be constructed using an equivalent of 4 bars of 25mm box/pipe equivalent as a minimum. Panels must be anchored securely to a solid object i.e. truck, post. Juniors and Juveniles are not permitted to ride/handle stallions at any time. Electric tape perimeter is also to be erected. See new updated rule 11.12

Prize money: ACA guidelines will be followed for prize money, see Rule 8 & 9(b)

Strictly no dogs: on the grounds, you will be asked to leave or place the dog elsewhere.

Please do not build horse yards around trees or cross-country jumps. Also, no manure to be left around trees or under jumps please.

Competitors to be neat and presentable at all times – Collared buttoned shirts (no t-shirts), boots, jeans/jodhpurs and hats or hard hats (no caps) will be allowed in competition

Please bring clean hay!
