PLEASE READ SO YOU ARE FULLY AWARE OF OUR RULES

- ACA Membership season is 1st April until 31st April
- Competitors are restricted to a minimum of 8 first round starts
- Dogs are welcome, keep on leads and keep barking to a minimum
- Stallions to be doubled tied, tied and hobbled or hobbled in steel yards
- No substituting horse or rider after event commences
- No refunds if you withdraw less than 72 hours prior to the start except under exceptional circumstances. As per ACA regulation D.5
- Under no circumstances are persons under the age of 17 years of age permitted to ride or handle stallions within the perimeter of the grounds.
- Stallions are permitted to be unrestrained in panel yards during daylight hours but must be double tied after dark. Only 1 horse per enclosure. Panels must be a minimum height of 1500mm and constructed using an equivalent of 4 bars of a

minimum width of 25mm box/pipe equivalent. Panels must be securely fastened to a solid point.

Riders under the age of 18 years must wear an approved riding helmet when riding at any time at the venue.

Prize money as per R.7 & R9.

The committee reserves the right to alter the program without notice.

Competitors please note if you do not have ambulance cover and an ambulance is required, you will be required to cover all ambulance costs.

Canteen and Bar facilities available all weekend—NOT Friday.

Dinner tickets to be sold at the bar

DO NOT BRING OUTSIDE HAY ON TO THE GROUNDS OR YOU WILL BE ASKED TO LEAVE. Hay will be available Friday afternoon and Saturday morning.

Turn back riders please note: It is a great way to warm your horse up but REMEMBER it is a job to get the cattle off the arena as fast and smoothly as possible.

When your ride has terminated PLEASE help to remove your beast from the arena, don't leave it all up to the turn back riders.
