- 2. Nominations open via Campdraft Central https://www.campdraftcentral.com.au/ on Friday 8th February 6am until Saturday 9th February 6am. All nominations must be paid in full by Friday 15th February, if not paid, nominations will be scratched to make room for wait listed competitors nominations are confirmed only on receipt of payment made in full.
- 3. Riders limited to 15 first round runs (The Committee reserves the right to restrict nominations further in the event of excessive nominations and the availability of cattle)
- 4. All riders to ride at their own risk.
- 5. All horses will be run in order of the draw.
- 6. The status of a horse winning a campdraft will be determined by the highest class of horse with exception of Juniors, Juveniles, Ladies, Old Buffers, Associates and Encouragement Campdrafts. The winner attains the status of the highest class of horse participating e.g. if one Open horse competes then it is classed as an Open draft.
- 7. Judges decision in all cases will be final.
- 8. Any competitor who wishes to lodge a complaint at an affiliated Campdraft must lodge the complaint in writing with the Secretary of the host committee within one hour of the incident taking place. A fee of \$20.00 must be lodged with the complaint. If the complaint is dismissed by the committee the \$20.00 is forfeited.
- 9. Unless otherwise advised competitors can regard their entries as having been accepted, but the Committee shall in no way be responsible for non-receipt of such entries.
- 10. The decision of the committee on all matters pertaining to the competition shall be final and conclusive and binding on all nominations for the events.
- 11. In addition, the Committee reserves unto itself the right at any time, without being liable for any loss or damage which may be sustained, to alter or postpone that date of events, or cancel the same or to change the venue of the events.
- 12. Nominations will be refunded in full if notified 7 days prior to draft.
- 13. Scratching's 7 days prior to 8am of draft (return 100%); then can keep \$15; then 4 days prior to 8am of draft (keep 100%)
