The status of a horse winning a campdraft will be determined by the highest class of horse that competes with the exception of Juniors, Juveniles, Ladies, Old Buffers, Associates and Encouragement campdrafts. The winner attains the status of the highest class of horse participating (e.g. if one Open horse competes then it is classed as an Open draft).

**Riders under the age of 18 must wear helmets whilst mounted on a horse at all ACA affiliated events.
Helmets must comply with current safety standards and be securely fastened under the chin at all times .**

A 100% refund of the deposit shall be given if a competitor withdraws more than 7 days prior to 8am on the first morning of the program. If a competitor withdraws within 72hrs prior to 8am on the first morning of the program the committee is entitled to keep the entire amount of the competitor's nomination fee, unless extenuating circumstances apply.

Please note that changes to program may occur to assist with the running of the draft and animal welfare.
