The committee reserves the right to alter or amend the program depending on number of nominations received and the availability of stock. 4. Nominations must be paid in full for entries to be accepted. 5. Any competitor who wishes to lodge a complaint at an affiliated Campdraft must lodge the complaint in writing with the Secretary of the host committee within one hour of the incident taking place. A fee of \$20 must be lodged with the complaint. If the complaint is dismissed by the committee, the \$20 is forfeited. 6. Each competitor must acknowledge that it is a condition of acceptance of their nomination that the Campdraft Committee will not be responsible in respect of injury, loss or damage. 7. Riders under the age of 18 must wear Helmets whilst mounted on a horse at all ACA affiliated events. Helmets must comply with current safety standards and must be securely fastened under the chin at all times. 8. Every person who competes at an ACA affiliated Draft must now be a full member of the Association.
