4. All Scratchings are in accordance with ACA Rule D.5.
5. All Prizemoney will be paid as per ACA Rules R.6 - R.9.
6. No prizemoney will be released until your **BIOSECURITY FORM** is lodged with the Committee.
7. If we source sufficient cattle, & receive good nomination numbers, we may addback to the prizemoney.
8. Riders under the age of 18 years must wear an approved safety helmet, with the chin strap secured at all times, even when **NOT** competing.
9. No changes permitted to horse or rider names, or order drawn after 1 hour prior to the start of event.
10. All Stallions must be restrained according to the NCCA Rule 11.12.
11. **ALL** electric fences, even those with no stallions, must be connected to a working electric fence energiser and power source. The liability associated with stallions, or any escaped horse/s, falls on the owner of the escaped horse/s.
12. Acceptance of all or any nominations is at the Committee's discretion.
13. The **COMMITTEE** MAY RESTRICT, ALTER, ADD or DELETE ANY PART OF THE PROGRAM or PRIZES.
14. **PRESENTATIONS** will be held immediately after the completion of each event, unless otherwise advised.

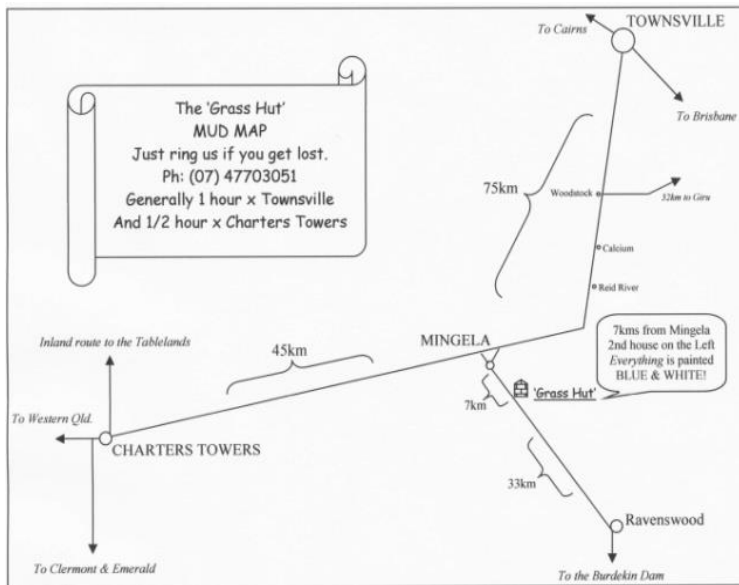

- There is NO POWER sorry. BYO Generators. Water is precious so please be mindful.
- Campfires are fine, provided all due care is taken. Please extinguish fires overnight.
- There are LIMITED TOILETS and SHOWERS. PLEASE be clean as we have a tiny committee.
- ALL camping is inside the cooler opposite the arena. Please do not hook up to toilet's power as it is just a small solar set up, or the toilet's water or there will not be enough pressure to shower.
