2. Riders under the age of 18 must wear a helmet while mounted on a horse at all times. Helmets must comply with Australian standard 3838 or better and be fastened at the chin at all times.
3. The committee reserves the right to alter or amend the program.
4. Nominations will only be accepted via Campdraft Central.
5. The judge's decision is final in all drafts
6. Maximum of 2 changes per competitor if made prior to draft commencements
7. Scratching's per ACA rule D.5
8. Prize money to be paid according to ACA rules R8 & R9
9. A Horse Event Waiver Form must be signed by all competitors prior to competing.
10. A Horse Health Declaration including PIC details must be provided to the Secretary prior to the commencement of the draft

Toowoomba Campdraft Entry Conditions

- Accepted and paid nominations are carried forward.
- Once notified nominations are accepted, they must be paid in full by Wednesday 17th May 2019.
- The Committee reserves the right to add or delete restrictions if necessary.
- A Horse Event Waiver Form must be signed by all competitors prior to competing.
- A Horse Health Declaration including PIC details must be provided to the Secretary prior to the commencement of the draft.
- All nominations include GST and all prize money is GST inclusive.
- Horses must be nominated in the order that the rider wishes to ride.
- Scratching's before 21st May 2019 will receive a full refund.
- Scratching's between 21st May & 24th May 2019 will forfeit \$40 per nomination for cattle hire.
- Scratching's after 24th May 2019 will forfeit all nominations unless when extenuating circumstances apply.
- Riders under the age of 18 must wear helmets whilst mounted on a horse at all ACA affiliated events. Helmets must comply with current safety standards and must be securely fastened under the chin at all times.
- All competitors ride at their own risk.
- Juvenile Draft is restricted to two runs per competitor.
- Junior Draft is restricted to one run per competitor.
- Junior competitors are only permitted to ride in the Junior Draft.
- Any competitor who wishes to lodge a complaint at an affiliated Campdraft must lodge in writing with the secretary of the host committee within one (1) hour of the incident taking place. A fee of \$20 must be lodged with the complaint. If the complaint is dismissed by the committee the \$20 is forfeited.
- Each competitor must acknowledge that it is a condition of acceptance of their nominations that Australian Horse Events Pty Ltd will not be responsible in respect of any personal injury, loss or damage.
- The Committee may change, alter, add or delete to the program as they see fit.
- All competitors must be financial members of the ACA before the weekend commences.
