PLEASE NOTE: Horses are restricted to two first round runs per horse excluding Ladies, Restricted Open, Junior and Juvenile drafts and competitors are restricted to eight first round starts

Scratchings received within seven days of the draft will forfeit \$10, unless extenuating circumstances apply. Scratchings received after Tuesday May 21st will forfeit the whole amount of the nominations.

NOTE: ALL COMPETITORS MUST BE FINANCIAL MEMBERS OF THE ACA

“Riders under the age of 18 must wear a helmet whilst mounted on a horse at all ACA affiliated events. Helmets must comply with current safety standards and be securely fastened under the chin at all times.” *Prizemoney in accordance with ACA Rule R.9* “Rider&/or horse may break status the status of a horse winning a campdraft will be determined by the highest class of horse with exception of Juniors, Juveniles, Ladies, Old Buffers, Associates and Encouragement Campdrafts. The winner attains the status of the highest class of horse participating e.g. if one Open horse competes then it is classed as an Open draft. The committee reserves the right to alter the program as required.

THERE WILL BE NO CHANGES ACCEPTED ONCE A DRAFT HAS COMMENCED AND ANY CHANGES DONE AFTER FRIDAY 10am WILL INCUR A GOLD COIN DONATION.
