This fee can be retained if competitor doesn’t withdraw in the allotted time frame. If Competitor withdraws within 72hrs prior to first morning of program, committees are entitled to keep the entire amount of the competitor’s nomination, unless when extenuating circumstances apply
Riders under the age of 18 must wear a helmet at all ACA affiliated events. Helmets must comply with current safety standards and be securely fastened under the chin at all time
