**COVID 19 Management Plan is in place and all officials, volunteers, competitors & spectators must abide by it.** COVID 19 signed declaration form will be required to enter the grounds, further information closer to the event. People are expected to stay up-to-date via the Hamilton Campdraft Facebook page and current Victorian Government Guidelines.

## **Conditions of Entry:**

- **Membership:** Events are ACA affiliated. ACA rules Apply. No ACA casual memberships are available. Any competitor, or person, intending to ride a horse on the Gazette Campdraft Grounds (even if not competing) must be a full financial ACA member. For membership forms go to the ACA website or contact the ACA office on 07 4622 3110. All non-Financial members are NOT authorised to compete. As an Affiliated ACA committee, ACA advises to NOT allow any Non-Financial ACA Members to complete unless they can provide you with proof of payment by way of a paid ACA Tax Invoice ONLY.
- **Nominations:** Entries via campdraft Central only. [www.campdraftcentral.com.au](http://www.campdraftcentral.com.au) All competitors will be emailed/invoiced via Campdraft Central once entries are finalised. If payment is not received by 30/01/2021 your position will be given to the next wait-listed competitor.
- **Scratching:** Refunds applicable to scratching as per ACA rule D.5. A 100% refund of the nomination fee will be given if the competitor withdraws more than 168 hours (7 days) prior to 8:00am on the first morning of the program. If a competitor withdraws less than 168 hours (7 days prior to 8:00am on the first morning of the program), then the entire nomination fee may be retained by the committee. If the committee deems that extenuating circumstances apply, then a refund may be granted. Each case will be at the discretion of the committee.
- **Prizemoney:** All prizemoney paid as per ACA guideline R8-R9
- **Mini Draft:** Mini's should be in full control of their horse at all times. Mini's are not to be lead whilst in competition. Mini's should try and not make contact with the beast. Mini competitor and parent to follow rules set out by the judge on the day.

## **General Conditions:**

- The committee also reserves the right to alter the programme as deemed necessary.
- Changes to horse/rider must be done in writing at secretary's office at least 1 hour before the event begins. NO CHANGES WILL be ACCEPTED DURING THE EVENT OR AT THE ANNONCERS OFFICE.
- All dogs must be kept on a lead and under control at all times. STRICTLY NO DOGS past the shed, on the built up area near the camp/arena, or within the food preparation areas. Any dog/s creating a problem will be removed.
- Any competitor who wishes to lodge a complaint at an affiliated campdraft must lodge the complaint in writing with the Secretary of the host committee within one hour of the incident taking place. A fee of \$20 must be lodged with the complaint. IF the complaint is dismissed by the Committee, the \$20 is forfeited.
- Junior and Juvenile competitors are not permitted to handle or ride stallions which on the Gazette Campdraft Grounds.
- Riders under the age of 18 must wear a helmet whilst mounted on a horse at all ACA affiliated events Helmets must comply with current safety standards and be securely fastened under the chin at all times.
- By nominating in this event and/or entering the grounds, you are agreeing to abide by all conditions of entry.
- **Horses Status:** The status of a horse winning a campdraft will be determined by the highest class of horse that competes with the exception of Juniors, Juveniles, Ladies, Mens, Old Buffers, Associates and Encouragement campdrafts. The winner attains the status of the highest class of horse participating (eg if one Open horse competes then it is classed as an Open draft).
- **Encouragement:** An Encouragement campdraft competitor shall be 17 years and over and one who has not won 1 Encouragement or 1 Open age draft, or placed 3 times in an Open age campdraft.
- **Futurity:** The definition of a Futurity Draft is for horses four years and under.
- **Juvenile/Junior:** Juvenile (13 years to under 17 years) and Juniors (8 years to under 13 years).
- **Stallions:** All stallions are to be contained in accordance with Rule 11.12 of the ACA Rules.
